Choose a campus that's right for you, and get ready for a great beginning to a story that will change your life.



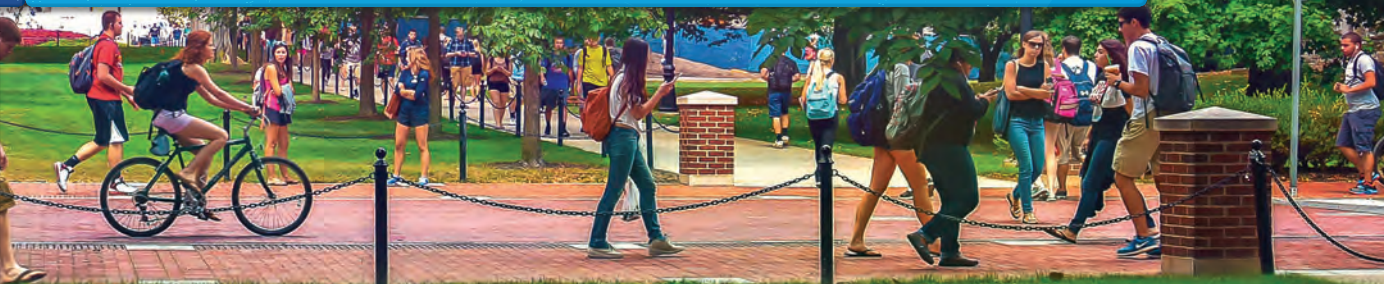


## EXPLORE YOUR OPTIONS


